Each of you will create a presentation about your province that you will either deliver to the class or record so that we can watch it. If you plan on submitting a project that we will watch, I highly recommend using Spark Video. In either case, you may speak for no more than twenty seconds on each topic you address.

Using the table below, you must accrue 35 points worth of information on your province. You may propose other topics to address as well. If they are appropriate, I will assign a point value to it.
