No matter the product that you choose, I will be looking for the following elements.

- A clearly stated argument/position on 1631. Pick a side. Remember that you have to vote on the issue. Remember our AREAS model: your argument answers a question. In this case this the question is how would you vote on 1631? There is no middle option. (5 points)
- You must have two or three reasons why you have taken the position that you did. Remember that reasons answer the question why. (10 points)
- You must have at least eight cited pieces of evidence. I am not going to ask you to create a bibliography or footnotes for this project but I do want you to note where you got your information. (24 points)
- Lastly, I expect you to put some care into your product. This is not just proofreading your message but making sure that it communicates your message well. (5 points)

The project will be worth a total of 44 points.
